Bindoon Primary School has a Dress Code that outlines the standards expected of students. Our school uniform plays an important role in promoting a positive image of our school and supports all students to participate fully in school life. This Dress Code can help create a sense of identity and a school culture in which every student experiences a sense of belonging.

The school's colours of dark bottle green and gold are reflected in the uniform. Both new and second hand uniform can be purchased from the P&C Uniform Shop. Clothing items bought from other suppliers can be worn as long as they match in terms of colour, style and length.

This Dress Code has been agreed to by the Bindoon Primary School Board on 7 April 2022.

Everyday Uniform items:

School polo shirt – gold, with green side panels and green school logo

School Year 6 leavers shirt – dark green, with gold side panels, school logo and 'Year 6 Leaders'

School zip front jacket – dark green, with gold trim and school logo

Windcheater –dark green, with school logo

Shorts – dark green with gold piping

Skorts – dark green

Dress – dark green, with gold side panels and school logo

Track pants fleecy – green

Track pants microfiber – green

Bucket hat – green, reversible with faction colour

Note

- Bike pants/leggings of a dark green colour can be worn as an undergarment
- Shorts, skorts and dress are to mid-thigh length or longer
- Hats must be worn for outdoor activities. A 'No hat, No play' plan is in place.

Sport Uniform items:

Faction shirt – faction colour

Shorts – dark green

Students are expected to wear their sport uniform every Friday, as well as for sport and faction events. Faction shirts have the name and logo of their faction. They are named after local flora, fauna and landmarks.

- Carnaby – red - cockatoo
- Needonga – blue - lake
- Wandoo – green - tree

Other items available from the Uniform Shop:

Satchel

Footwear:

Sneakers – compulsory for sport

Closed-in flats

Sandals with back straps

No thongs, boots, platform, strapless shoes or glaring long socks

Hair:

To be neat and presentable

For safety reasons, hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back

Jewelry:

For safety reasons only the following jewelry is permitted – watch, medic alert bracelets, sleeper or stud earrings, neck chain under clothing, cultural or religious items.

Make-Up:

Clear nail polish or medical lip balm

Other make-up only when permission is granted
